

End of KS2 Performance Data

Pupils in our specialist centre, Leo Class, do not sit the national curriculum end of key stage tests due to working below key stage standards. The number of Y6 children who attend Leo Class varies year upon year.

In school we track and analyse pupil performance data for all pupils, both mainstream and in the Centre. When analysing data and setting targets, we create two separate sets of data, one set including all the pupils in the age group and another including only the pupils who are in the mainstream classes. This enables the performance data to be compared more accurately to other schools which do not have specialist centres. **Please see the data in brackets for the outcomes of the mainstream class alone.**
