 Use a phonics grapheme chart to help.

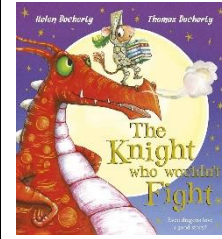


**Home learning – Literacy**

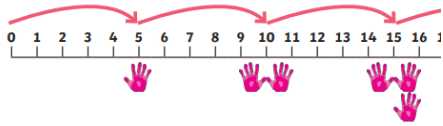
**Home learning – Literacy**

**Home learning – Maths**

Practise looking for the addition and subtraction symbols in number sentences an adult at home writes for you. What do you have to do when you see the + symbol? What do you have to do when you see the – symbol?



**Home learning – Maths**

Counting backwards and subtraction is a big focus this half term. Can you count backwards every day, starting from 20, then 30, 40 etc. until you can count back from 100.

Make a model of a plant and label the key parts. What materials can you use for this?

Find out about the different castles and palaces in the UK. Can you look at a website to find out some facts? Maybe you can do a virtual tour?

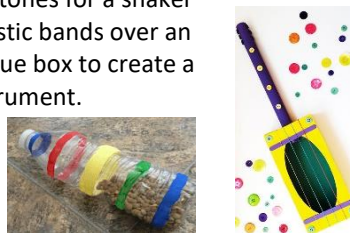
**Home Learning Activities**

Create your own castle out of things you would otherwise throw away. What features of a castle can you include? Can you add some labels?



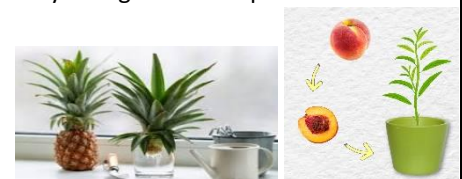
**Home Learning Activities**
