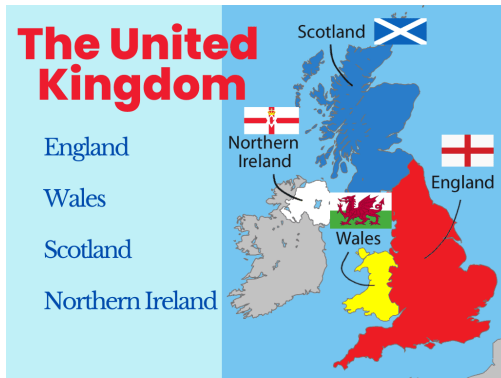


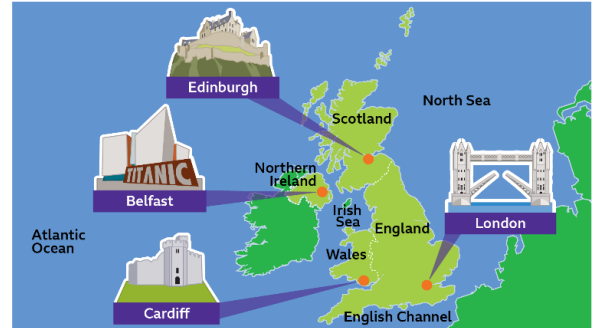
**Countries of the United Kingdom

2) What are the capital cities of the countries of the United Kingdom?
The capital cities of the countries of the United Kingdom are: London (England), Edinburgh (Scotland), Wales (Cardiff) and Belfast (Northern Ireland).



3) What are some landmarks that you can find in the United Kingdom?
A landmark is a feature or structure around the world that is easy to recognise. They can be physical features or human features.



4) What are some of the longest rivers in the United Kingdom?
The longest rivers in the UK are: The River Severn (Wales), The River Thames (England), The River Tay (Scotland) and the River Bann (Northern Ireland).



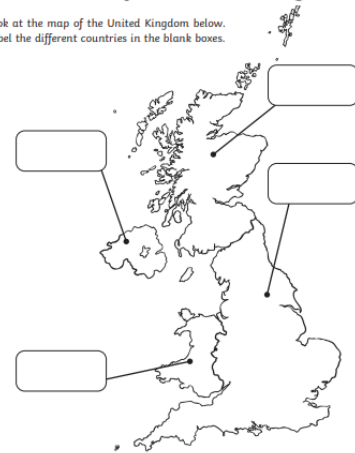
5) What are the tallest mountains in the UK? What is the climate like in the UK?
The tallest mountains in the United Kingdom are: Ben Nevis (Scotland), Snowdon (Wales) and Scafell Pike (England).
The climate in Southern England is warm in the summer and wet and cold in the Autumn, Winter and Spring. The climate in Scotland is colder than Southern England because it is further north.
